## Prof Vassilis Monastiriotis

Vassilis Monastiriotis is Professor of Political Economy at the European Institute, London School of Economics and holder of the Eleftherios Venizelos Chair in Contemporary Greek Studies at LSE. He is Affiliated Professor at the Department of Geography and Environment, LSE, and Director of the LSE Centre for Research on Contemporary Greece and Cyprus (Hellenic Observatory).

He has expertise in the fields of labour economics, political economy, industrial policy and economic development and relevant policy experience working with various national and international organisations. His publications include articles in journals such as Oxford Economic Papers, the British Journal of Industrial Relations, the European Journal of Political Economy, the Journal of Common Market Studies, the Journal of Regional Science, Regional Studies, Urban Studies, and others.

He is Co-editor of Spatial Economic Analysis (Taylor & Francis), member of the Scientific Council for Social Sciences of the National Council of Research Technology and Innovation of Greece and various advisory and editorial boards. In 2018-2021 he served as member at the Independent Experts Committee on the Minimum Wage in Greece.

## Dr. Tasos Anastasatos

Dr. Tasos Anastasatos is Group Chief Economist of Eurobank, Chairman of the Steering Committee for Economic Analysis of the Hellenic Bank Association and Member of the Executive Committee of the Hellenic Bank Association. Dr. Tasos Anastasatos is also a Research Associate at the University of Piraeus.

Previously, he has served as Secretary General of the Hellenic Ministry of Finance and Chairman of the Council of Economic Experts (SOE), EuroWorking Group Member for Greece; Visiting Member of Staff, Athens University of Economics & Business; Economist, Bank of Greece; Lecturer, Loughborough University.

He holds a Ph.D. from the University of Warwick, an M.Sc. (Warwick) in Economics and Finance, and a B.Sc. in International and European Economic Studies from the Athens University of Economics and Business.

Dr. Anastasatos has published extensively in market research publications, academic journals, and the media in the areas of macroeconomics, financial economics, and the Greek economy; he has co-authored three books.
